

**REF: REACH REGULATION n° 1907/2006**

Dear Sir/Madam,

Regarding the European Regulation n°1907/2006, also known as REACH, I would like to inform you that we are abreast of the new obligations connected to the management of chemical substances, preparations that are mixtures of substances and articles made with these products.

We further inform you that ARGUS SPECTRUM INTERNATIONAL has, with its suppliers, undertaken the action necessary for confirmation that the procedures required by the Regulation have been applied and, where applicable, the pre-registration and registration procedure of the substances contained within preparations and/or articles supplied by them have been carried out.

We produce articles through an industrial process and we are fully aware of the obligation to relay the information contained in article 33.1 or the regulation to our clients, that being:

- the name of substances which come under the criteria of article 57 (identified according to article 59 paragraph 1) and therefore subject to authorization, when a concentration of over 0.1% of the total weight is present within the article;
- instructions for the safe use of printed circuit boards in case of the existence of such substances.

Any information deemed as necessary will be supplied following publication of the candidate list by the ECHA Agency, as outlined by the Regulations.

At today's date, there are no SVHC substances in the products and preparations supplied to us and used for the production of our finished product listed in the current edition available which contains 205 substances (last updated: 16/01/2020).

We will take every care to communicate any information or change in the situation of products supplied by us, their safe use or possible substitution, as outlined by the Regulation.

We remain at your disposal for any further clarification required.
